- Educate patients and their families on treatment plans, home exercises, and strategies for improving functional outcomes.
- Assess and recommend adaptive equipment for safe discharge plans
- Participate in daily rounding and care plan meetings with patients and an interdisciplinary team.
- Collaborate with the healthcare team, including physicians, nurses, and other therapists, to ensure coordinated and effective patient care.
- Ensure compliance with hospital policies, procedures, and regulatory requirements in all aspects of patient care and documentation.
- Maintain a clean, safe, and organized work environment, adhering to infection control and safety protocols.

- Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree from an Occupational Therapy program from an accredited institution. Master's Degree preferred.
- Current licensure as an Occupational Therapist in Pennsylvania.
