- Ensure compliance with all local, state, and federal regulations and professional standards, in addition to hospital policies, for all aspects of patient care and documentation.
- Use therapeutic exercises, modalities, and equipment appropriately and safely.
- Participate in staff meetings, continuing education, and quality improvement initiatives.
- Maintain a clean and safe work environment in accordance with clinical protocols and safety standards.

- Master's Degree in Physical Therapy from an accredited institution; Doctorate preferred.
- Current licensure as a Physical Therapist in Pennsylvania with preference given to Direct Access candidates.
